
On the cover of the Wildcat Book will be a wildcat emblem with a big "W". The color scheme of red and gray will be used.


Fuller To Edit

FOREWORD

This revised edition of the Wildcat book is for you, whether you are a new student at Waggener or a graduating senior.

The rules, information, and suggestions will be of considerable value to you in the planning and execution of your high school program. The directory has been placed in the book for your convenience. Read thoroughly and learn about your school. It is believed that, through a further acquaintance with the school program, our school pride and spirit will be second to none.

The "W" book is also directed toward the parents in the belief that only through their confidence and support our school can achieve and prosper.

HISTORY OF WAGGENER

Waggener Junior High School was named in honor of Mayme Sweet Waggener, a well-known and beloved educator in the St. Matthews area from 1916 until her retirement in 1946. She began her teaching career in the Louisville schools, transferring to the county's Greathouse Elementary School in 1916. In 1918, she became principal there and served in that capacity for twentyeight years.

Mrs. Waggener died in 1953, and on October 26, 1954, Waggener Junior High was dedicated to her memory.

Waggener is located on a 22-acre site and the original cost, exclusive of land, was over a million dollars. It was the first completely separated junior high school in the history of the Jefferson County educational system.

In 1957, when there was a 10th grade for the first time, the school's name was changed to Waggener High School. In 1960, our first senior class was graduated. They had been accommodated in new yearly-completed wings since 1957.

Mr. John B. Lowe was Waggener's first principal. In 1959 Mr. Lowe was succeeded by Mr. Earl Duncan, assistant principal. The growth of Waggener necessitated the appointment of two assistant principals and four guidance counselors.


Waggener High School is an accredited secondary school, member of the Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. It is an important part of the community of St. Matthews and is one of the finest high schools in this part of the country.


MR. EARL DUNCAN


Mr. Duncan was born in Georgetown, Kentucky, on August 21, 1920. He graduated from Oxford High School in Scott County, and received his A.B. in education from Morehead. He also has his Masters degree from the University of Indiana.

In high school he was picked for the first all state basketball team picked by Earl Ruby in 1939. While at Morehead he became one of the best basketball players that has ever come from the state of Kentucky. One time he personally outscored the total opposition.

Mr. Duncan then entered the Marine Corps where he received his basic training at Parris Island and at Quantico Marine Base. He then went to Officers Candidate School. In 1943 Mr. Duncan came to Jefferson County as a teacher at Fern Creek High School. Mr. Duncan transferred to Jeffersontown High School for the year 1943-1944 where he was head basketball coach. In 1950 he transferred to Eastern High School as basketball coach where he coached two county champs. Mr. Duncan continued serving in this capacity until Waggener. In 1957 he became the assistant principal, and in 1959 became principal.

ATTENDANCE

The pupil is held accountable for his absence and tardiness. Undue absence and tardiness will not be tolerated. Pupils who enter the premises may not leave until the close

of the day, unless excused through the office.

If a pupil arrives at school after 8:15, he must report to the office, otherwise he will be counted absent for that day and so reported to his parents.

HALL PASSES

Pupils must get permission slips before they leave their classrooms for any reason. A pupil must have this permission from his teacher at all times.

LOCKERS AND LOCKS

All pupils are assigned lockers. The locks for the lockers can be secured in the book store. Any personal lock will be removed if it is on someone's personal locker.

BOOK STORE

The school book store is open in the mornings for business each day. Books and school supplies are available at the book store.

LOST AND FOUND

Lost articles may be claimed at the Lost and Found Room off the main lobby. Bring to this room all articles that are found. They will be marked with the finder's name.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in the school building or on the grounds during the school hours. This is a state law, not merely school policy.

CAFETERIA

All students are required to go to the lunch room during the lunch hour. A well-balanced plate lunch, including milk, may be bought in the cafeteria for thirty-five cents. Extra milk may be purchased. Students who bring their lunches should leave them in lockers until lunch-time. Students are not permitted to leave the school grounds during the lunch hour.

PARKING

All automobiles, motor scooters, and bicycles must be parked behind the school building in the spaces provided for them. Do not park in front of the building. This space is for visitors only.

If a student is excused and has occasion to leave school in a car during the school day, he should do so quietly. The speed limit in the school zone is ten miles per hour.

The riding of motor scooters and bicycles is not permitted during school hours.

FIRE DRILLS

Fire drills are required once each month by state law. They should be conducted with such ease and efficiency as will prepare every individual in the building to meet an actual emergeney.

Pupils must maintain absolute silence and move quickly and in an orderly fashion. Specific instructions as to route and exit from the building are given by the teacher. Each teacher accompanies his class to the campus, fifty feet from the exits,

LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to borrow books from the library, a student must present his library card. A library card is given each student at the first of the school year. The right to borrow books may be revoked at any time due to abuse of library privileges. All books may be withdrawn for 14 days with the exception

of reference books, reserved books, and magazines. A book may be renewed for an additional week providing the borrower brings the book to be restamped on the day it is due.

A book lost by a student must be paid for by the end of the semester or the student will not receive his credits for that term.

Waggener can never acquire an adequate library unless her students exercise care and consideration in the use of the books. Do not take any book out of the browsing area unless it is properly issued to you by a library assistant.

APPOINTMENTS

Appointments with the Principal, Assistant Principals, and the Counselors can be made any time during the school day. Teachers should be consulted during their free periods or at the end of the school day if possible.

BUS REGULATIONS

The right of all pupils to ride in this conveyance is dependent upon their good behavior and observance of rules and regula tions. Any pupil who violates one of these should be reported to the school principal.

- 1. The driver is in full charge of the bus and the pupils.
- 2. Pupils shall obey the driver cheerfully and promptly.
- 3. Pupils should be on time; the bus cannot wait for those who are tardy.
- 4. Pupils should observe the following:
 - a. Never stand in the road while waiting for the bus.
 - b. Clean shoes before entering the bus.
 - Avoid spitting on the floor of the bus.
 - d. Do not throw waste paper or other rubbish on the floor of the bus,

your employer and your parents granting you permission to work. Your employer must also give his telephone num-ber. A pass will be given you to leave school by the assistant principal if permission is granted.

- 4. You become ill.
 - You should report to the teacher of your present class. He will excuse you to go to the sick room. If it is necessary for you to go home, you will be excused through the main office and your parents notified.

5. You are absent.

Absences are excused only for illness of student or serious illness or death in the family. The day you are absent the parent calls the office and gives you a note to be returned to school and given to home room teacher.

Curriculum

GENERAL INFORMATION ON CURRICULUM

From year to year Waggener High School is constantly changing its program of curriculum. Revision and improvements are being made.

In order for a student to meet graduation requirements be must complete at least 18 units of work over a four-year period (grades 9-12). Certain subjects are required of all students. Additional subjects will be required if a student wishes to qualify for a particular occupational field, special training, or college entrance. Beyond these requirements a student may choose as elective subjects any additional subjects which will help him to reach his goal or add to his personal growth.

A typical college program should include four years of English, at least two years each of science, mathematics, social studies, and foreign language. Major colleges and universities prefer four years of English, four years of science and four years of college preparatory mathematics, and they recommend two

- Pupils who must cross the road after alighting from the bus should pass in front of the bus and not behind it.
- Should any pupil persist in violating any of these regulations. the driver shall notify the principal and after due warning has been given the pupil, he shall be forbidden the privileges of again riding the bus until permission has been granted to do so.
- 7. Complaints of drivers, pupils, and parents should be reported to the principal.
- Should the conduct of a pupil on the bus endanger the lives or morals of other people and the offending pupil fails to cease such conduct when requested to do so by the driver, it shall be the duty of that driver to put the offender off the bus and report his action to the principal immediately.

WHAT TO DO IN CASE:

1. You must leave school before 3:00 o'clock.

- If your parent wishes you excused due to a doctor or dentist appointment, see the assistant principal and get a medical excuse blank from him to be signed by the doctor and returned to the office.
- 2. You arrive at school after 8:15. Sign the tardy sheet in the office lobby and get admittance slip from office.
- 3. You wish to be excused the last period to work
 - You must present to your home room teacher letters from 13

years or more of foreign language, and two years of social studies. Students should consult the catalogues of colleges of their choice for admission requirements.

Each student should plan his program around a core of subjects which apply more directly to a field of employment he plans to enter. All students in grades 9-12 are expected to enroll in 5 classes each year. Any student may combine four academic subjects with one of the following to make a fifth subject: choral music, orchestra, band, art, home economics, health and physical education, and industrial arts. Only those students having above average grades should enroll in 5 academic subjects

TRACT PROGRAM

The Tract program plan of education was started at Waggener during the fall of 1959. Waggener does not have all of the pro-grams that are offered. It has: the Advanced for the gifted students, the Superior for the above average students, and the Regular for the average and below average student. The main purpose of this program is to enable a pupil with varying degrees of ability to find his proper level of achievement. Each student is enrolled in one of the programs that is designed for his interest and abilities. The trachers, counselors, and principals with the interest of the student in mind decide which program is best for the student. A student may move from one program to another.

THE CORE PROGRAM

The seventh and eighth grade core program at Waggener is a type of organization to gradually change the student from the grade school program to the high school program.

Under the core program all reading and writing subjects (literature, grammar, spelling, history, science, and health) are fused together in a three-hour period under one teacher.

This program places emphasis on teacher-pupil planning, individual and group participation, evaluation, work habits, and democratic living.

A pupil receives one grade for all the subjects included in core. The other subjects: mathematics, home economics, shop, physical education, band, art, and music, are taught by special teachers of the subjects. The pupil receives separate grades in each of them.

Departments

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

One unit of health and physical education, taken in high school, is required for graduation. Physical education is offered in the eighth grade but must be taken again in the ninth unless

GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT

Waggener High School has an excellent Guidance Department. Counselors and teachers help students study themselves, to understand their problems and to work out appropriate plans for studies.

The nine point system of counseling includes individual and group counseling, test coordination and special test referrals, orientation of new students, referrals of special cases, conferences with teachers and parents, and different grade level counseling. The Guidance Department Staff is: Mrs. Dawson for 8th, 10th, and 12th grade girls Mrs. Hays for 7th, 9th, and 11th grade girls Mr. Aspy for 8th, 10th, and 12th grade boys Mr. Corey for 7th, 9th, and 11th grade boys

These counselors alternate even and odd years so that they have the same groups of people each year.

The Guidance Program places added responsibility upon the student and parent to plan for the future in making intelligent and proper choices of curriculum and goals.

THE POINT SYSTEM

A student's class ranking is determined by the total of his "quality points." The point system which Waggener uses gives 4 points for an A, 3 for a B, 2 for a C, 1 for a D, and 0 for an F.

the student is physically handicapped. A student who enrolled in Waggener after the ninth grade and doesn't already have one unit of health and physical education must obtain this before graduation.

In Physical Education the boys compete in speedball, touch football, wrestling, tumbling, basketball, volleyball, track and softball. The girls compete in volleyball, soccer, basketball, group games, folk dancing, and softball. A physical fitness test is administered at the end of the course

The health course at Waggener strives toward various objectives. Some of these objectives are contained in the following principles:

- The educated person understands the basic facts concerning health and disease
- The educated person protects his own health and that of his 2. dependents.
- The educated person works to improve the health of the com-3. munity.

WAGGENER'S MUSIC DEPARTMENT

Waggener's music department is under the direction of Mrs. Bernice Ely, Mrs. Eleanor Ritchie, and Mr. Carl Markert, It consists of general music classes, a junior high chorus, senior high chorus, a cappella choir, girls' chorus, girls' and boys' ensembles and also similar vocal groups. We have a beginning band and orchestra, as well as our marching band and fine symphony orchestra.

These groups regularly give concerts and play for assembly programs as well as bring honor to the school through outside presentations to local civic groups.

CHOIR

The Waggener Choir is directed by Mrs. Ely. It sings for both the school and the community. The choir is made up of students who are selected by Mrs. Ely. It meets for one period five days a week and offers one credit.

ADVANCED CHORUS

Waggener's Advanced Chorus is directed by Mrs. Ely. The members are senior high students who are interested in singing. The chorus sings for the senior high school programs and also community programs. It meets five days a week for one period and offers one credit.

ADVANCED ORCHESTRA

The Waggener Advanced Orchestra is directed by Mrs. Eleanor Ritchie. It plays for both school and community programs. The orchestra is made up of students who are selected by Mrs. Ritchie. The orchestra meets every day and you may receive one credit for taking it.

SENIOR BAND

The Waggener Senior Band is directed by Mr. Carl Markert. The band gives both school and community performances. To become a member you must be in at least the eighth grade and you must be able to play an instrument well enough to earn a position in it. The band meets one period every day. A student may earn one credit by taking it.

THE ENGLISH DEPARTMENT

English is the only subject in the curriculum that all students must take in grades seven through twelve. In the seventh and eighth grades it is taught as a part of the core program. In the ninth through the twelfth grades it is taught on a departmental basis and is grouped into superior and regular classifications. Speech, journalism, and dramatics are offered as electives within the English department.

THE MATH DEPARTMENT

The Math program at Waggener High School consists of these courses: General Math and Advanced Arithmetic; Business Arithmetic for commercial students; Algebra I and II; Plane and Solid Geometry; and Trigonometry. The Special Math classes under the direction of Mrs. Ruth Pardon include these areas of mathematics: Plane and Solid Geometry; Algebra I, II, and III;

- To provide students with practical driving experience through behind-the-wheel driving instruction.
- 5. To conserve life and property
- To acquaint students with the construction, function, and maintenance of motor vehicles.
- 7. To teach students the courtesies of driving.
- 8. To instill a safety consciousness in each student.
- To establish understandings of and proper attitudes toward causes of accidents.

DRAMATICS CLASSES

1/2 Credit (2 Classes)

The dramatics course is a combination of academic work and activities. We study the history of the theater, play production, and plays. We produce scenes from recognized plays, pantomimes, and a one act play.

ART DEPARTMENT

The Waggener High School Art Department is composed of Junior High Art for grades seven and eight, and the High School Art program for grades nine through twelve. The program for grades seven and eight is planned with utmost creativity, general hackground of appreciation and variety of experience as its major goals.

In the High School curriculum, the following courses are offered every day, and one full credit may be earned:

Art I (General Art) — A good basic training in fundamental techniques and use of inventive ideas, and participation in a variety of creative experiences.

Art II (Advanced Art) — A continued development of technique and creative ideas with an emphasis on design, composition, color, and the graphic arts.

Art Appreciation — An academic course consisting of a study of the history of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture from Cave Man to Twentieth Century. (Excellent background for preparation for college.) Trigonometry; Calculus; and Analytical Geometry. Special reports are given in these classes the Junior year.

Waggener has the distinction of being one of the four county schools which have the advanced program under the Five Tract System. These classes are started in the seventh grade and run through the twelfth grade. All the areas taught in the Special Math classes will also be covered in the advanced program in addition to studies of other number systems, etc.

INDUSTRIAL ARTS

The Industrial Arts Department offers courses in general shop and mechanical drawing. A special building adjoining the school houses these classes,

General shop is primarily for seventh and eighth grades. Instruction in woodworking, leather, and metal tooling are given.

Three years of mechanical drawing are offered to high school students. In the first year, a student receives a general introduction, including work on three views, isometrics, and architectural drawing. The second year is a detailed study of architectural and machine drawing. In the third year, the student specializes in his major intent.

The three teachers in the Industrial Arts Department are as follows: Robert Bauer, Dennis Ball, and William Hughes.

DRIVER'S TRAINING EDUCATION

This course, Driver's Education, is offered at Waggener as a one semester subject. Each student experiences two periods per week in classroom study and an average of eight hours behind the wheel and twenty-four hours of additional observation in the car. For this the student receives ½ credit.

- The following are the objectives listed for this training:
- To develop in students attitudes, habits, and skills necessary to be safe and courteous drivers and pedestrians.
- To create respect and understanding of the necessity and purpose of state and local traffic laws, rules, and regulations.
- To help reduce the increasing number of traffic accidents and fatalities especially among high school students.

These High School courses are designed to give students basic experience for both the fine art and the commercial art fields. They are broad in scope and both specific and experimental with techniques and ideas.

Organizations and Publications

THE STUDENT COUNCIL

"The purpose of this Council shall be to give the students an opportunity to make suggestions for and to participate in student activities, to co-ordinate the activities of the various home rooms so that a feeling of unity will prevail, to encourage high scholastic attainment, to promote good school spirit and sportsmanship, to encourage growth in good citizenship, and to provide an opportunity for training in government." This is the purpose of the Waggener Student Council as stated in the constitution. The Student Council does not act as a government of the students but rather as a link between the students and the administration.

During the year the Student Council has several projects which it does annually. These include the publication of this book, the welfare program for needy families, the selling of booster tags for football and basketball games and in general doing things around the school that need doing.

There are two Student Councils at Waggener, the senior high council and the junior high council. The senior high council is made up of students from grades nine through twelve and the junior high council is composed of seventh and eighth grade representatives. Each home room elects representatives on a democratic basis meeting the requirements of the Student Council Constitution.

THE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society is a national organization to recognize and promote scholarship, leadership, service, and character among high school students. In order to qualify for membership in the National Honor Society, a student must maintain a scholastic average of ninety for five semesters. Then the student is voted on by a board of faculty members.

Honor Society students not only contribute to school activities, but also do social work in the community.

THE NATIONAL BETA CLUB

The purpose of the National Beta Club is to promote the ideals of honesty, service, and leadership among the high school students of America, to reward meritorious achievement, and to encourage and assist students to continue their education after high school. A student who wishes to join the Waggener Chapter of the Beta Club must be either a junior or senior and have a general scholastic rating of at least eighty-eight.

All members try to the best of their ability to remain loyal to the motto, "Let us lead by serving others."

NATIONAL THESPIAN SOCIETY

The National Thespian Society is a high school drama organization. The society is open to students from grades 9-12. The requirement for membership is: one bundred hours of work in theatrical productions, either in technical or acting positions.

YOUTH SPEAKS

Youth Speaks is an organization for Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors, which works toward . . "creating better human relations, encouraging personal citizenship responsibility in the process of discovering, developing and applying the moral and spiritual values inherent in the democratic way of life." (from the Youth Speaks Constitution)

Able students in English and Social Studies are chosen by members of the faculty to represent the school in the Youth Speaks meetings. All members try to live up to their motto, "Youth builds socially, spiritually, and scholastically."

FUTURE TEACHERS OF AMERICA

Students in grades 9-12, who are interested in becoming teachers, have a chance to gain an insight into classroom pro-

cents a year in dues. The club supplements the Spanish classes and promotes interest in the Spanish people.

The executive board is made up of two representatives from each Spanish class. Each of the representatives is either the president or the secretary-treasurer of his Spanish class.

THE GERMAN CLUB

"Die Deutsche Gesellschaft" was founded at Waggener in 1960. All students taking German above the first year level are eligible for membership. Any first year student who has at least two A's and a B at mid-year is invited to join at that time.

The activities at the monthly meetings provide the student with incentives for continued study and enjoyment of the culture of the people who speak German.

WORLD AFFAIRS CLUB

The World Affairs Club is open to any Waggener student who is interested in his country and his world. The members discuss the present world situations and have speakers talk to them about different countries.

SCIENCE CLUB

The Science Club helps the growth of science at Waggener. The club is organized in sections, such as physics and chemistry.

The Science Club supports the Science Fair held at Waggener in which many Waggener students participate. It also provides a means for upper-classmen to further their interests in science, and it introduces the under-classmen to the field of science.

MATH CLUB

The Waggener High Math Club was organized for the benefit of those who have a real interest in mathematics. Speakers are invited to talk on the aspects of math not available in the current curriculum. The club now is open only to seniors but may soon be open to all those who are interested. cedure through the Future Teachers of America. By being teachers aids students are given the opportunity to show their ability and to broaden their perspectives.

FUTURE BUSINESS LEADERS OF AMERICA

The Future Business Leaders of America is composed of members from the business classes at Waggener. The F.B.L.A. listens to speakers from the business world and participates in the state convention which meets in Louisville.

FUTURE HOMEMAKERS OF AMERICA

The Future Homemakers of America is a home economics related club. Its main purposes are to promote a growing appreciation of the joys and satisfactions of homemaking and to foster the development of creative leadership in home and community life. The F.H.A. is opened to any student who is in junior or senior high school that is taking or has taken a homemaking course. Their motto "Toward New Horizons" reminds members that their contributions to home life today will influence the kinds of homes they have tomorrow.

THE FRENCH CLUB

The French Club was formed for the purpose of enriching the course. The members see movies and interesting information about France. Students who are eligible are third and fourth year students. Also, second year students may join at the end of the first semester, provided they have an A average.

THE LATIN CLUB

The Latin Club is for Latin students with an A or B average. The members are divided into Senators, Knights, and Plebians; first year students are slaves.

Meetings are held once a month and dues are 50c. Club activities include a Roman hanquet and production of Greek or Roman plays.

SPANISH CLUB

Requirements for membership in the Spanish Club are met, first by being in a Spanish class and second, by paying fifty

HEALTH CAREERS CLUB

The Health Carcers Club is for students in grades 7-12 who are interested in a medical career. The club visits hospitals, have doctors speak to them, and watch movies at school.

The Co-ed Hi-Y Club is an association composed of Waggener High School students who are interested in serving their community. Each year the club participates, together with other club members throughout the state, at the Kentucky Youth Assombly and the Kentucky United Nations Assembly.

The club meets every other Wednesday night at the Y.M.C.A. (St. Matthews). The meetings consist of panel discussions, speakers, films, reports, and various types of recreation. Every year the club undertakes one main service project as their main feature.

In order to be eligible for membership a member must be a high school student with a desire to better serve his community.

CHESS CLUB

The purpose is to promote better understanding of chess in general and to gain a better knowledge of the game.

Membership is open to any Waggener student who shows an interest in the art of chess. The sponsor is Mrs. Paula Pendergrass,

COIN CLUB

The Coin Club is open to any Waggener High student interested in coins or coin collecting. At meetings, the members discuss coins and have speakers discuss coin collecting with them.

GARDEN CLUB

The Waggener High Garden Club is the first in the area. Once a month the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth grade girls discuss flowers and flower arranging. They also attend flower shows in the area.

CITIZEN BAND RADIO CLUB

This club was organized in 1961 with the purpose of enforcing Citizen Band rules and engaging in social activities. Membership is open to all interested radio fans.

KEY CLUB

The Key Club is a new organization at Waggener, though it is found in many other sections of the country. Its primary func-tion is to interest young people in various activities. Membership is open to boys in grades 10-12.

PEP CLUB

The Pep Club is an organization of students who are interested in working to make Waggener a better school. Members come from all grades and their attitude is one of interest for the welfare of their fellow students, which they show through their participation in the club's work of bolstering school spirit.

THE WAGGENER HIGH SCHOOL DRILL CORPS

The Waggener High School Drill Corps was organized on August 31, 1959. It was organized because girls wanted more extra-curricular activities in which to participate.

The qualifications are good character, ability to march, and no failing grades. The girls are selected by a committee of former band and drill corps members. The girls have performed in Centre's Homecoming. They also perform at selected basketball and football games.

LAIR

The Lair is the written and pictorial history of Waggener High School. It is published annually by a student staff. The sponsors choose the members of the staff for their English abilities, as recommended by previous English teachers.

The staff operates on a series of three deadlines. At each deadline one-third of the final edition is shipped to the Taylor Publishing Company in Dallas, Texas. The finished book comes out in the spring.
