We only mark those if we are sure of their death. Many of the names in red may have passed on, but we have not found anyone to verify the death.

Young Hinrichs was the son of the general manager of Girdler Division of Chemetron. He was an athlete with an outstanding academic record at Waggener High School where he was a junior.

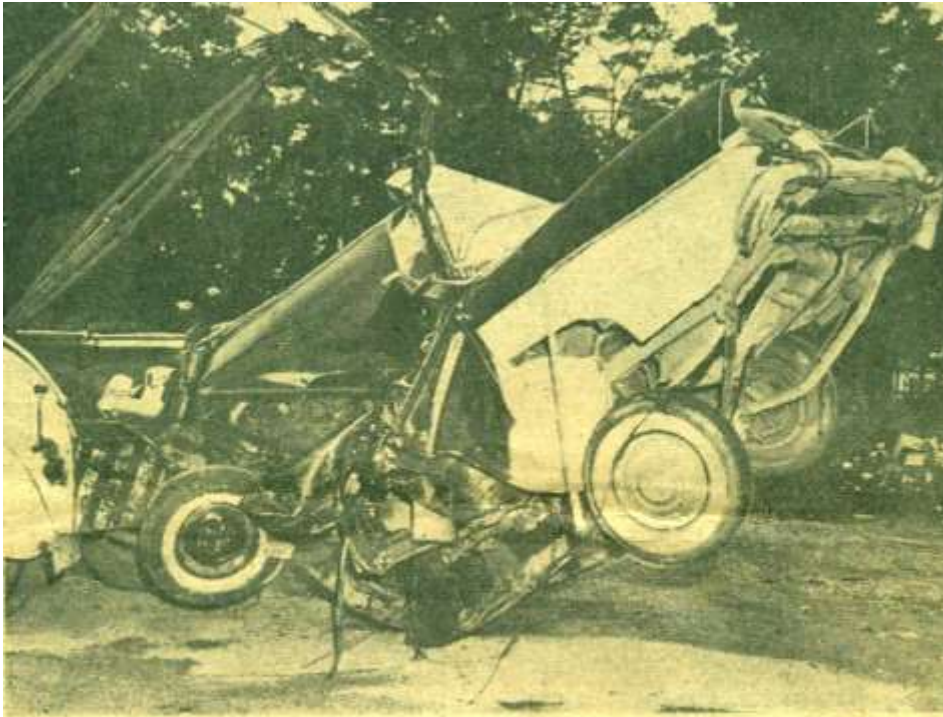
Miss Henderson was a University of Louisville student. Her father is general manager of Hoffman Water Heater Division of Lawson Manufacturing Co.
