








Oct 7-14

Our classmates toured WHS Saturday morning, Reunion Weekend. We were welcomed by Dr Sarah Hitchings, Principal and led on the tour by Jamie Dumsdorf, Athletic Director and WHS Alum. Dr Hitchings briefed us on the multiple programs at Waggener and their driving goal of "Making all students college and career ready, one Wildcat at a Time". They have college prep and career prep and most students have the opportunity to earn college credit for one or more courses during their junior and senior year.













Dr. Sarah Hitchings told us about (1) the implementation of technical career programs such as Sports Medicine and Legal Services, about the Capital Improvements such as the career support buildings, the rubberized athletic track that is a joint facility with the City of St Matthews, the new gymnasium that is large enough to seat both home and visitor fans (negating the need to play basketball off site as we did in our day), the impressive Veterans Memorial in the football stadium and the plans for an auditorium to allow meaningful assemblies and performing events for the students as well as a community resource for the City of St Matthews. The architectural renderings above are indicative of the facility that will be eventually built on the northwest side of the school. The School Board has earmarked approximately 2/3 of the funding and community leaders are seeking support for the balance.
